**THE COLLEGE**

Sivananda College of Pharmacy, Berhampur – 10, Ganjam, Odisha, is a premier professional institution, which is situated in the heart of city. This institute is established in the year 2004 with the blessings of Swamy Sivananda Guru Maharaj. The college first commenced with the Diploma in Pharmacy course from the year 2005-06 with an intake capacity of 60 students per annum. The college is approved by the **Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi**, affiliated to Odisha State Board of Pharmacy, Bhubaneswar and recognised by the Govt. of Odisha.

**LOCATION OF THE COLLEGE :**

Berhampur is a cosmopolitan city in South Odisha, which is also known as “Silk City”, has the scope for versatile career making.

The college situated 3 Kms. away from the bus stand, 4 Kms away from the Railway station, 1 Km from MKCG Medical College & Hospital, Berhampur, only 100 meters away form Engg. School Square. Berhampur is well connected through buses and trains with rest of the country. The nearest airports are Bhubaneswar (165 kms.) and Visakhapatnam (250 kms.).

**ACADEMIC SCHEDULE:**

Sivananda College of Pharmacy, Berhampur- 10 offers the following discipline.		
Course	:	Diploma in Pharmacy.
Duration	:	2 Years & 3 Months.
Eligibility	:	Have passed 12 <sup>th</sup> / 10 + 2 Science (Academic Stream) examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and/or Mathematics (passed individually in Theory and/or Practical) from C.H.S.E., Orissa or any examination equivalent to it, approved by Pharmacy Council of India (Student of Vocational/Open University are not eligible) and must have completed 17 years of age.
Intake capacity	:	60 students per annum.

**SELECTION PROCEDURE :**

Admission shall be made on merit basic through State Govt. conducted by Convener, D. Pharm Selection Committee, S.C.B Medical College, Cuttack. Admission notification issued for this course in leading Oriya daily News papers usually in the month of July/August every year. After Govt. counseling is over vacant seats will be filled up by the college the propectus.

**DOCUMENTS REQUIRED :**

The attested Xerox copies of the following certificates / testimonials must be enclosed to the application and the original should be produced at the time of admission.

1.	10 <sup>th</sup> /H.S.C pass or equivalent certificates in support of date of birth (if the D.O.B./subjects are not written in the H.S.Certificate but appears on the Admit Card/Mark-sheet then the same is to be enclosed and Other certificate of age such as Certificate from Headmaster/Principals of the School/College, birth certificate from hospital or municipality etc. are not acceptable).
2.	Mark-sheet of the 12 <sup>th</sup> / +2 Science or equivalent examination.
3.	Pass certificates of the 12 <sup>th</sup> / +2 Science or equivalent examination.
4.	College Leaving Certificate / Transfer Certificate from the institution last studied.
5.	Migration certificate where applicable as per College Leaving Certificate / Transfer Certificate (Out of state candidate also to provide Affidavit of genuineness before an Executive Magistrate).
6.	Conduct certificate issued by the Principal of the institution last studied.
7.	Residential/Nativity Certificate from Tahasildar OR Service Certificate of parent/spouse.
8.	Certificate in support of SC/ ST/ OBC/ PH etc. if applicable.
9.	Six recent colour passport and two stamp size photographs.
10.	Eight (8nos.) self-addressed stamped (Rs. 5/-) envelop of size 10 Cm x 25 Cm.

**COURSE FEES :**

As prescribed by Govt. of Odisha and Examining Authority from time to time. Fees once paid shall not be refunded, under any circumstances. The fees should be paid in the form of Demand Draft drawn on in favour of '**Principal, Sivananda College of Pharmacy**', payable at Berhampur or in the cash counter of the college.

**TEACHING FACULTY :**

The college comprises of well-qualified & highly experienced Principal with committed teaching standards and other distinct faculty members recruited as per norms of PCI & UGC. Besides, eminent academic experts from various national level institutions industries & other areas, frequently visit for Guest lectures arranged at regular intervals.

**ACADEMIC SESSION & ATTENDANCE :**

The academic session of D. Pharm Part I class commences soon after the Govt. completes the Counseling / admission process. Each academic session consists about 240 working days spread over the year.

The eligibility for appearing the Board examination is 75% attendance in each theory and practical classes, students are however encouraged to put in 100% attendance for better academic results.

**EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION :**

Students are evaluated on the basis of sessional tests and Annual examination. Three sessional examinations are conducted during the academic year & students must attend all the examination without fail. However a student has to appear minimum two out of three sessional examinations in an academic session to be eligible for filling up forms for D. Pharm Part I & II examinations of Odisha State Board of Pharmacy, Bhubaneswar.

A student shall not be declared to have passed Diploma in Pharmacy examination unless he/she secures at least 40% marks in each of the subject separately in the theory examination, including sessional marks and at least 50% marks in each of the practical examination including sessional marks. The candidates securing 60% marks or above in aggregate in all subjects in a single attempt at the Diploma in Pharmacy (Part-I) or Diploma in Pharmacy (Part-II) examinations shall be declared to have passed in First Class the Diploma in Pharmacy (Part-I) or Diploma in Pharmacy (Part-II) examination, as the case may be. Candidates securing 75% marks or above in any subject or subjects shall be declared to have passed with distinction in the subject or those subjects provided he/she passes in all the subjects in a single attempt.

3. Students should prepare respective theory and practical classes according to the timetable.
4. Students should be very sincere on his/her duty and should not try to cheat at any time.
5. Students must (a) maintain strict discipline, (b) attend all classes and examinations regularly, (c) work hard and study well.
6. Students are required to be regular in attendance. If unavoidable absence on account of health, urgent private affairs or other reasons, they must be prepared to state the exact reasons for absence and produce necessary certificates.
7. Students are expected to behave with courtesy towards the members of the staff, their fellow students and all visitors to the institution.
8. Students should not wander in the corridors during the working hours. Utmost discipline must be maintained, or else disciplinary action will be taken and the parents will be called for explanation.
9. Students are required to wear uniform dress i.e. boys with navy blue colour pant & white colour shirt, girls with Salwar Kameej white colour and navy blue respectively.
10. All the students must wear white colour apron during practical classes.
